# SBA Administrator Guzman Lauds President Biden’s Budget for Fiscal Year 2025, Highlights Impact on Small Businesses

Administrator Isabel Casillas Guzman, head of the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) and voice in President Biden’s Cabinet for America’s more than 33 million small businesses, celebrated the President’s Budget for Fiscal Year 2025, which contains critical investments in the small businesses and innovative start-ups powering America’s Small Business Boom.

“President Biden’s Budget builds on his Administration’s unwavering commitment to strengthening entrepreneurial outcomes and opportunities across America,” said SBA Administrator

Guzman. “From providing small businesses with much-needed access to capital and training on how to grow their businesses to getting relief to communities impacted by disaster, the SBA ensures small business owners have the information and resources they need for their businesses. With the investments in the President’s Budget, the SBA will deepen its work serving the small businesses and innovative startups that drive that creation, our Nation’s economy, and global competition.”

Under the Biden-Harris Administration, the United States has experienced the first, second, and third strongest years of new business ap-

plication rates on record, with 16.5 million new business applications filed since the President took office. President Biden’s Budget protects and builds on this progress with proposals for responsible, pro-growth investments in America’s small business ecosystem.

## Specifically, the President’s Budget will:

- **Expand Access to Capital for Small Businesses:** The President’s Budget supports historic lending levels across the SBA’s business lending programs, including the

7(a) business loan guarantee, capital for major fixed assets (504 loan guarantee), Small Business Investment Company (SBIC), and Micro-loan programs. The more than \$58 billion in lending and investment authority in the Budget would address the need for greater access to affordable capital, particularly in underserved communities. The budget proposes statutory increases to the maximum SBA loan size for small manufacturers and exporters, as well as a new direct 7(a) lending program, which would further enable the SBA to address gaps in access to

# What You Need to Know About the Gender Wage Gap



Here are five fast facts:

- **Overall, women are paid less than men.** On average, women working full-time, year-round are paid 84% of what men are paid. In other words, the typical woman working full-time would need to work from January 1, 2023, until March 12, 2024, to make what the typical man working full-time made in 2023. This wage gap also persists within all major race and ethnic groups. For instance, Hispanic women (\$41,137 median annual salary) make 13% less than Hispanic men (\$47,420 median annual salary). This inequity is even greater for Black and Hispanic women when compared to white, non-Hispanic men.
- **The largest identifiable causes of the gender wage gap are differences in the occupations and industries** where women and men are most likely to work. In 2023, Black women lost \$42.7 billion and Hispanic women lost \$53.3 billion in wages as compared to white men due to the impact of occupational segregation. However, even within the same occupation, women make less on average than men.

- **A woman must complete at least one additional educational degree to earn as much as a man with less education.** For instance, on average, a woman with an advanced degree earns less than a man with a bachelor's degree. Were it not for the fact that women attain a greater number of degrees than men, the gender wage gap would be even larger.
- **The wage gap is larger for mothers and results in employment-related losses of more than \$295,000 over a lifetime.** This results in women having lower average incomes in retirement and less financial stability in old age.
- **Discrimination remains a likely leading cause of the gender wage gap.** Just since Fiscal Year 2022, the Department of Labor's Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs, the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Department of Justice have collectively recovered over \$20 million in monetary relief for women who have experienced pay discrimination in the workplace.

# Surety Trends to Keep an Eye on in the Construction Industry

Reflecting on the dynamics of the 2023 construction and surety industries, it is evident that opportunities and challenges have emerged for contractors that will shape the landscape for the year ahead. Contractors can not only capitalize on these trends but protect the successful companies they have already built.

### PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

There has been a notable increase in public works opportunities, driven by increased government spending and the aging infrastructure in the United States. This trend is expected to con-

tinue in 2024 and beyond, with a notable portion of work coming in transportation- and public-utility-related infrastructure.

Due to increased spending, many contractors are reporting historically high backlogs—and that often includes the largest project their company has contracted in their history. While increased spending presents more opportunity, it's critical contractors be even more diligent about new opportunities, giving additional consideration to the following:

**Job Selection:** New geographies, scope, project owners and/or subcontractor relationships commonly come with a learning curve. With the current state of the market, it's not the ideal time to be learning costly lessons. Contractors should

focus on having a proactive go/no-go strategy when reviewing potential projects to identify risks early and plan accordingly.

**Margins:** Contractors' pricing was slow to catch up with materials and labor cost escalations, which is reflected in the 2023 financial results. Contractors should internally set an acceptable floor for project margins and include ample contingencies to cover unforeseen challenges.

**Contract Terms:** Litigation is increasing, and contract terms are arguably becoming more onerous for both contractors and subcontractors. It is imperative proposed contracts are reviewed prior to bidding, to identify both upstream and downstream risk. Timely submission of pre-bid requests for information are critical in identify-

ing risks in new projects and pricing them accordingly.

**New Entrants:** Increased competition for work should be expected. Given the slow-down in private development, it is likely that contractors who do not typically pursue public works will step into that arena.

### SURETY MARKET

The surety market continues to grow, but there have been signs of more challenging times ahead. An increase in payment bond claims began to emerge in early Q2 2023.

small loans. In addition, increasing the authorized lending level for the SBIC program by 16 percent to \$7 million would significantly expand the availability of patient capital and equity investments across the Nation.

- **Support Disaster Mitigation and Recovery:** As communities across the nation face increased risks from natural disasters, the President's Budget continues to support the SBA's Disaster Loan Program. This program is vital to ensuring the SBA can continue administering low-interest disaster loans that provide a financial lifeline for homeowners, renters, nonprofits, and businesses recovering from these tragic events.
- **Deliver Equitable Access to Counseling and Training Resources:** The President's Budget proposes \$20 million for the Community Navigator Pilot Program, which works with community organizations to provide and amplify awareness of free and low-cost business counseling and training resources. Community Navigators have reduced resource and access barriers for underserved communities, including veterans, women, rural communities, and communities of color.
- **Build Capacity in Innovation and Government Contracting Opportunities:** The President's Budget proposes \$30 million to support the SBA's Growth Accelerator Fund Competition, Regional Innovation Clusters,

and the Federal and State Technology Partnership Program. By integrating SBA certification programs like 8(a) Business Development, HUBZone, Women-Owned Small Business, and Veteran-Owned Small Business Certifications into the MySBA structure, small businesses will have one streamlined point of entry to apply for multiple certifications and access their information.
- **Support Prudent Oversight and Fraud Risk Management:** The President's Budget provides resources necessary for the SBA and OIG to continue to effectively manage,



oversee, and investigate potential fraud and unqualified recipients in the agency's COVID-19 relief programs.
