Bullet train budget battle: Should California spend more on urban transit, not high-speed rail?

High-speed rail was supposed to connect California's urban hubs: Los Angeles and San Francisco. Now, it's struggling to muster enough political support to connect the tiny towns of Madera and Shafter.

Thirteen years since California voters approved \$10 billion to build a bullet train, Democrats who run the state government are divided over

spending the money to finish building the first section of track — a 119-mile stretch in the Central Valley.

Though Gov. Gavin Newsom proposed pouring \$4.2 billion into completing the segment, law-makers balked and left the funds out of the June budget. Now, the governor and fellow Democrats who control the Legislature are negotiating how

much to chug along by laying track in the farm belt — or whether to spend more on transportation projects in more heavily populated regions.

"Typically what you'd see with projects like this is they'd start where the people are at and then radiate outwards. So, we would have started building high-speed rail in the San Francisco

Bay Area, down in LA, and then eventually connect it," said Ethan Elkind, director of the climate program at the UC Berkeley School of Law.

"We did this really backwards, and now we're starting to really see the

Mayor Garcetti announces collaboration with Microsoft to establish veterans tech training program

Mayor Eric Garcetti announced a collaboration with Microsoft to establish the Los Angeles Veterans Technology Training Academy (LAVTTA), a free, four-month training program that will prepare veterans for careers in software engineering, cloud application development, and cloud administration.

"Veterans have given so much to our country and the least we can do is help connect them to opportunities to thrive here at home," said Mayor Eric Garcetti. "The men and women who served our country in uniform are some of the most diligent and hard-working people in Los Angeles and this new program will give them a chance to tap into a thriving sector of our economy and make a living for themselves and their families."

Based on the Microsoft Software and Systems Academy (MSSA), Los Angeles is the first city in the nation to introduce a tech training program for its military veterans. While the MSSA program is tailored for transitioning service members during their last six months of service, LAVTTA will be available to all veterans, including those who have already transitioned out

of the military. All veterans living in the City or County of Los Angeles will be eligible to apply.

LAVTTA is made possible by a collaboration between the Mayor's Office of Military and Veterans Affairs, Microsoft, the Los Angeles County Workforce Development Board, JVS SoCal, and Fastlane. Boeing, Microsoft, and the City of Los Angeles Information Technology Agency will also partner with the program to offer mentoring, organizational insights, and interview opportunities.

"Microsoft believes its role as an industry leader is to enable veterans to see computer science and STEM careers as a viable path when transitioning to civilian life in the public or private sector," said Chris Cortez, Microsoft's Vice President of Military Affairs. "The Los Angeles Veterans Technology Training Academy, based on the MSSA, also helps Microsoft and other IT leaders attract capable, driven and diverse talent with solid, transferable skills."

LAVTTA's intensive 16-week program will provide training for a range of careers in the tech sector, which will be geared toward jobs in soft-

ware engineering, cloud application development, and cloud administration. The course will also offer classes on general professional development, including resume prep, interview skills, and translating skills learned in the military into traits valued by companies.

"This program is perfect for service members that couldn't participate in a Skillbridge program before they transitioned due to deployments and operational commitments," said Larry Vasquez, Director of Military and Veterans Affairs for the City of Los Angeles. "It may be particularly attractive to veterans who have completed some undergraduate coursework and are looking for a new opportunity."

The Los Angeles Veterans Technology Training Academy, working with Microsoft's 700+ employer partners, will connect graduates to companies based in Los Angeles to provide employment opportunities and mentorships. White House touts broadband part of new infrastructure deal

The White House announced Wednesday that its "once-in-a-generation investment in our infrastructure" would include a part dedicated to improving Americans' access to the internet.

Later, the Senate passed a critical test vote by 67-32, suggesting possible passage of the entire infrastructure bill in the coming days.

"This bipartisan deal is the most important investment in public transit in American history and the most important investment in rail since the creation of Amtrak 50 years ago," President Joe Biden said in a statement Wednesday afternoon. "It will deliver high speed internet to every American."

Neither precise details of the broadband section nor the text of the whole bill has been released yet. The White House said in a related statement that a \$65 billion investment for broadband, out of \$550 billion in new spending, would ensure that "every American has access to reliable high-speed internet," comparing it to the electrification of the country a century ago.

The National Telecommunications and Information Administration, part of the Commerce Department, published a comprehensive interactive online map last month. The document shows how poorer, more rural and tribal areas generally don't have affordable broadband access.

The Federal Communications Commission defines broadband as a download speed of 25 megabits per second and an upload speed of 3 Mbps. While 25 Mbps is generally sufficient for most uses, when such a connection is shared via a wireless connection and transmitted to multiple people using different devices, real-world speeds — particularly when videoconferencing is involved — are often slower and insufficient.

A draft copy of the 68-page broadband section of the infrastructure bill obtained by NBC News would establish a de facto minimum standard of 100 Mbps down and 20 Mbps up, and it would require that internet service providers have an eye toward even higher speeds, most likely through fiber optic service. In addition, it would require the federal government to establish a single website where consumers could determine whether they are eligible for low-cost broadband.

"The main takeaway for me is that it's oriented around future-proofing infrastructure, and that's a good thing," said Ernesto Falcon, a lawyer with the Electronic Frontier Foundation in San Francisco.

Vinhcent Le, a technology equity lawyer with the Greenlining Institute, an advocacy organization in Oakland, California, was part of a coalition of pro-consumer groups that lobbied the bipartisan working group in recent months.

"It doesn't rock the boat too much, but it does give things that advocates have been asking for: better mapping data and digital inclusion money, helping pay down the cost of broadband," he said. "It's going to help people get signed up."

Most major ISPs have low-cost programs, but critics have said that they aren't always widely known and that the speed floor has historically been too low.

In February, Comcast doubled the speed of its low-cost program, known as Internet Essentials, from 25 Mbps to 50 Mbps. Comcast, the country's largest internet service provider, owns NBCUniversal, the parent company of NBC News.

"We've always offered the same super fast speeds across an entire city when we build out and offer gig speeds across nearly our entire footprint of 55 million plus homes," Sena Fitzmaurice, a Comcast spokesperson, said by email. Fitzmaurice declined to comment on the White House announcement until legislative language has been released.

"We've been part of a coalition which has called for a permanent broadband program to help lowincome households, and have been participating in the emergency program including allowing customers to use it to access any tier of broadband service," she said.

The White House is also pushing to pass the Digital Equity Act, a bill to create "a permanent program to help more low-income households access the internet."

NCTA, the lobbying organization for telecommunications companies, said it was generally in favor of the deal.

"Connecting every American to robust and reliable broadband infrastructure is a goal we share and our industry has spent decades building and upgrading networks that now reach 80% of U.S. homes with superfast gigabit speeds," Brian Dietz, a spokesperson for NCTA, said by email.

"While we still need to see the details of the bill, we are encouraged that the bipartisan infrastructure deal directly addresses two critical elements of reaching universal connectivity — dedicating funding first and foremost to those regions without any broadband service, and providing financial assistance to help low-income Americans subscribe to this critical service," Dietz said.

harder to compete for federal funds with other states. The last time Newsom publicly questioned the project, the Trump administration yanked \$1 billion — funding that was only recently restored by President Biden.

"We are going to bat at the federal level for the funding necessary to build this first-in-the-nation high-speed rail system, and we urge the State Legislature to maintain its commitment at the state level," U.S. Senators Dianne Feinstein and Alex Padilla wrote in a letter to legislative leaders this week.

But the Legislature isn't so fast to green-light more money. Key lawmakers, especially in the Assembly, say they don't see the benefit for their Southern California constituents. And even if the bullet train eventually reaches Los Angeles and San Francisco, some legislators are skeptical that car-centric Californians will become train riders without more exposure to public transit in their daily lives.

"How (do) we turn California car culture into a California culture of transit of all sorts?" said Assembly Transportation Committee chairperson Laura Friedman, a Glendale Democrat. "That is the big question — and how does high-speed rail interact with that?"

Until then, she is reluctant to pump more money into a train through the sparsely populated Central Valley. With a quarter of California's population living in Los Angeles County, Friedman

would like to see money spent on improving Union Station in Los Angeles, the Metrolink commuter rail and transit between the San Fernando Valley and LA's Westside.

She said she doesn't see why California needs to immediately devote \$4 billion more to high-speed rail when "they're spending a billion and a half a year."

The Newsom administration says high-speed rail construction is at a critical point. Money is needed now to complete the final piece of the Central Valley portion, according to Brian Annis, chief financial official at the California High-Speed Rail Authority. And, he said, the state is on the cusp of choosing a contractor to lay the bullet train's track. That'll cost money, too.

"The project has taken longer than originally thought. The scope has increased, which has added some costs," Annis said. "But again, we're hitting some major milestones here where we're almost fully completed with our design."

Without this funding, the Newsom administration argues, fewer workers will be needed and layoffs could start as soon as next summer.

More than 75% of those workers hail from the Central Valley — about 1,100 head to construction sites daily for jobs that come with health care and hard-to-find stability. For one Central Valley carpenter, working near home for more than three months at a time had been uncommon.

Goats and sheep are helping the City sustainably prevent wildfire – here's how

More than 1,300 grazing goats and sheep have descended upon 130 acres in Del Paso Regional Park as part of a "Grazing Pilot Program" through the Department of Youth, Parks, & Community Enrichment (YPCE) to help sustainably reduce fire fuels.

"The City is responsible for many open spaces that require mowing to reduce fire fuels," said Park Planning and Development Manager Raymond Costantino. "Del Paso Regional is a location that has limited access for our large mowers and flailing units. The animals can get where our equipment cannot."

This is the first time YPCE has utilized livestock to reduce fire fuels.

"We are seeing grazing at many surrounding municipalities," Costantino said. "Grazing is a sustainable way to reduce fire fuels, such as grasses."

Mowing also can create large amounts of dead plant material, known as thatch, which creates

higher fire fuels and can reduce the success of native grasses and forbs, said Costantino.

This is a new endeavor for the City, and YPCE is working to develop the program during this pilot

"Utilizing sheep and goats for grazing is a step in the right direction," Costantino said. "We are fine-tuning the areas to be grazed, the duration of the grazing, the amount of residual dry matter left on the ground and the mix of goats and sheep to help us learn how to best apply this program to other parks in the city."

The animals are provided through a contract with a ranching company. The grazing is expected to be completed by mid-September.

At the end of the pilot, the City will evaluate whether the livestock have successfully reduced fire fuels and will decide whether to move forward with the program annually.

Visitors to Del Paso Regional Park should expect trails to be intermittently closed while the animals are grazing.

EPA Announces two Northern California Winners of President's Student Environmental Awards

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in partnership with the White House Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ), is pleased to announce the 2021 recipients of the Presidential Innovation Award for Environmental Educators (PIAEE) and the President's Environmental Youth Award (PEYA). In Watsonville, Mount Madonna School's 5th Grade's "Save Our Sharks - A Fintastic Tale" video earned one national award, while Pleasanton 11th grader Hiya Shah's Maji-Water Education and Security project was another winner.

"This past school year has been one of the most challenging for our nation, yet students and teachers across the country remained dedicated to tackling the most pressing environmental challenges we face – from climate change to environmental justice," said EPA Administrator Michael S. Regan. "I'm so proud of the remarkable youth and educators we're honoring today, and their work to make a difference in their communities. By working hand in hand, we can create a more sustainable, more equitable world."

"It is humbling and inspiring to see the impact these educators and students are having on their communities and our planet," said White House Council on Environmental Quality Chair Brenda Mallory. "I congratulate the awardees and the schools they represent for applying their creativity, leadership, and passion to solving the environmental problems of our time, from confronting the climate crisis and conserving our lands and waters to pursuing environmental justice for all. These remarkable educators and students are leading the way toward a more equitable, sustainable and healthy future."

"SOS: Save Our Sharks - A Fintastic Tale" is a student-driven project that supports shark conservation. The 5th grade class at Mount Madonna School in Watsonville created an educational movie to show how people's choices impact sharks and the marine ecosystem, raised funds for shark conservation, wrote letters to elected representatives to support a shark fin trade ban, and cleaned up local beaches.

Hiya Shah, an 11th grade student, developed a project called "Maji-Water Education and Security" that involved a youth-led outreach campaign and a full-length documentary. In response to PFAS found in some of Pleasanton's groundwater wells, Hiya helped make real-time water quality information accessible through a mobile app (called Maji) to promote proactive

approaches to conserve water, prevent water pollution, and secure clean water access to communities. Hiya also designed a bioinspired PFAS removal and filtration system that reduces energy requirements.

In California, four additional student projects were recognized as Honorable Mentions for the President's award:

- The Evergreen Makers are a team of seven 11th graders from San Jose, who created an autonomous mobile robot that uses machine learning and environmental data to suggest optimal crops and rotation patterns called Croptomize.
- Ina Kathleen Chun, an 11th grader from Irvine, developed a project to address food insecurity and climate change called, "Green Gardens/Global Interactions of Topsoil Loss."
- The Green Team and Progressive Club, a group of five 12th graders from Chula Vista, work to address plastic pollution through their project, "Recycle Plastic Waste into Asphalt Roads." The team worked with California Senator Hueso to write State Bill (SB) 1238, which he introduced and was passed in the California Senate.

Kelly Tung, a 10th grader from Cupertino, founded the Youth Environmental Power Initiative (YEPI), a nonprofit organization that promotes alternative transportation, safe biking and walking to lead future leaders to fight against climate change and make positive changes for our environment.

The PEYA was established by the Environmental Education Act of 1970 and recognizes outstanding community-level environmental projects by K-12 youth. Each year, PEYA honors a variety of local projects developed by students, school classes, summer camp attendees and youth organizations to promote engagement in environmental stewardship and protection.
