

California Invests \$149 Million in Cutting-Edge Companies, Creating Nearly 6,000 Jobs

- This latest round of CalCompetes grants and tax credits awarded to 12 companies is projected to bring in almost \$1.3 billion of private investment and create nearly 6,000 jobs with an average salary of \$118,700
- In total, CalCompetes has awarded grants and tax credits to more than 1,200 businesses, creating nearly 165,000 jobs

Governor Gavin Newsom today announced that California has awarded more than \$149 million in grants and tax credits to 12 innovative companies, creating nearly 6,000 full-time jobs and bringing in an estimated \$1.3 billion in private investment over the next five years.

The funding, from the Governor’s Office of Business and Economic Development’s (GO-Biz) Cal-Competes program, is going to companies expanding their operations in California and advancing the state’s semiconductor manufacturing capabilities, building the next generation of electric vehicles and electric aircrafts, and more.

Department of Commerce to Establish U.S. Artificial Intelligence Safety Institute to Lead Efforts on AI Safety

The Biden-Harris Administration announced that the U.S. Department of Commerce, through the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), will establish the U.S. Artificial Intelligence Safety Institute (USAISI) to lead the U.S. government’s efforts on AI safety and trust, particularly for

evaluating the most advanced AI models. USAISI will support the responsibilities assigned to the Department of Commerce under the historic executive order that President Biden signed earlier this week.

Specifically, USAISI will facilitate the development of standards for safety, security, and testing of AI models, develop standards for authenticating AI-generated content, and pro-

vide testing environments for researchers to evaluate emerging AI risks and address known impacts. USAISI, led by NIST, will leverage outside expertise, including working with partners in academia, industry, government, and civil society to advance AI safety. In addition, USAISI will work with similar institutes in ally and partner nations, including with the UK’s AI Safety Institute, to align and coordinate work in this sphere. Today’s announcement coincides with U.S. Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo’s participation in the AI Safety Summit 2023 in the UK with Vice President Kamala Harris.

“Through the establishment of the U.S. AI Safety Institute, we at the Department of Commerce will build on NIST’s long history of developing standards to inform domestic and international technological progress for the common good,” said Secretary Gina Raimondo. “As President Biden takes swift action

to ensure the U.S. is a global leader on innovative, safe, and responsible AI, the Department of Commerce is eager to play its part. Together, in coordination with federal agencies across government and in lockstep with our international partners and allies, we will work to fulfill the President’s vision to manage the risks and harness the benefits of AI.”

“I am thrilled that NIST is taking on this critical role for the United States that will expand on our wide-ranging efforts in AI. The U.S. AI Safety Institute will harness talent and expertise from NIST and the broader AI community to build the foundation for trustworthy AI systems,” said Under Secretary of Commerce for Standards and Technology and NIST Director Laurie E. Locascio. “It will bring industry, civil society and government agencies together to work on managing the risks of AI systems and to build guidelines,

California High-Speed Rail Partners with Labor on Operating Nation's First High-Speed Rail Project

The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) and 13 rail labor unions announced today that they have entered an agreement that ensures the hard-earned gains in federal labor laws will be applicable to the operations of the nation's first high-speed rail project. The 13 rail labor unions include:

- The Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees Division (BMWED)
- Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen (BRS)
- International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers-Mechanical and Engineering Department (SMART-MD)
- National Conference of Firemen and Oilers 32BJ/SEIU (NCFO)
- Transportation Communications Union (TCU)
- International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM)
- Brotherhood of Railway Carmen (BRC)
- International Brotherhood of Boilermakers (IBB)
- Transport Workers Union of America (TWU)
- American Train Dispatchers Association (ATDA)
- International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers-Transportation Department (SMART-TD)
- Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen (BLET)
- International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW)

This agreement will cover an estimated 3,000 workers who will operate and maintain high-speed trains, facilities, and stations from the Bay Area through the Central Valley and into Southern California. The running of the 171-mile Merced to Bakersfield Section alone will create nearly 400 operating jobs, a number that will grow as the service expands beyond the Central Valley.

"Since the start of construction, the State's high-speed rail project has created thousands of good-paying union jobs throughout California," said Governor Gavin Newsom. "We're proud to continue our strong partnership with labor through the operations of the nation's first electrified high-speed rail service."

"The Authority is proud to continue its tradition of working with labor unions and we are pleased to have reached this important agreement that ensures we have the highest quality working conditions for our highly trained and qualified workers," said Authority CEO Brian Kelly. "This is essential to ensuring that California's high-speed rail system will be operated with the safest and highest quality of service for our passengers."

"As the nation's largest transportation labor union federation, we are proud to support monumental projects like the California high-speed rail project, which will deliver a modern, efficient, and green transit system while putting skilled union members to work," said Greg Regan, President of the Transportation Trades Department of the AFL-CIO.

"This historic agreement was made because the California High-Speed Rail Authority has a vision for the future, a vision that will assist the California economy, and provide good-paying jobs, and as we all know, trains are the best friend of our environment," said Dean Devita, President, National Conference of Firemen & Oilers District of Local 32BJ/SEIU.

"The BRS has supported CAHSR from its inception. High-speed rail is the future of public transportation, and we are committed to fostering growth and jobs in California. The BRS is proud to contribute to a sustainable and environmentally friendly transportation system. Our support will continue with each phase of this important project," said Michael S. Baldwin, President of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen.

"The Teamsters Rail Conference welcomes the opportunity to represent the workers who will play a vital role in the success of California's high-speed rail system," said Mark Wallace, President of the Teamsters Rail Conference. "Our members are proud to be Teamsters, and they know the importance of strong union con-

tracts. Rail Conference unions BLET and BMWED look forward to negotiating contracts that reflect the skill of the highly-trained professionals that they represent."

This agreement ensures that the employees doing traditional rail work on the project will be able to determine for themselves what representation, if any, they want, and that those employees can be covered by the Rail Labor Act, the Railroad Retirement Act of 1974, and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act. The agreement also ensures that basic labor provisions, including protecting employees from being questioned about their support or nonsupport for labor, and giving unions reasonable access to employees, will be enforced on the project.

To operate and maintain the high-speed rail system, the Authority will need to employ thousands of people across the state on its trains, at its stations, its heavy and light maintenance facilities, and other facilities in various capacities, including operating, engineering, maintenance of equipment, dispatch, on-board service, and clerical work.

The Authority has been committed to strong partnerships with labor for over a decade. In September, the Authority marked 10 years since the establishment of the Community Benefits Agreement. Signed and executed in 2013, this agreement promotes employment and business opportunities during construction while advancing training opportunities to targeted and disadvantaged workers.

To date, construction progress in the Central Valley has resulted in the creation of over 11,500 good-paying union jobs, with more than 1,600 skilled workers dispatched to a high-speed rail construction site each day. Nearly 75% of the jobs created on the project go directly to individuals from disadvantaged communities.

The Authority has also partnered with the city of Selma, the Fresno Economic Development Corporation, the Fresno, Madera, Kings, Tulare Building Trades Council, and the Fresno Economic Opportunities Commission to establish the Central Valley Training Center External Link

– a 12-week, pre-apprenticeship program. The no-cost, pre-apprenticeship training program is aimed at serving veterans, at-risk young adults, minority, and low-income populations in the Central Valley and provides them with hands-on construction industry training. Since the start of the training center, 151 students have graduated, with more than 1,000 inquiring about the program.

The Authority has begun to extend the 119 miles under construction to 171 miles of future electrified high-speed rail from Merced to Bakersfield.

There are more than 25 active construction sites in California's Central Valley, with the Authority having environmentally cleared 422 miles of the high-speed rail program from the Bay Area to the Los Angeles Basin, including the entire Northern California section from Merced to San Francisco.

SENIOR ADVISOR AND GO-BIZ DIRECTOR DEE DEE MYERS: "With the return of the grant program this year, we're excited to continue building on the incredible success of CalCompetes over the last decade. Supporting these types of forward-thinking, entrepreneurial companies helps guarantee that California's innovation economy will continue to provide family-supporting jobs and return sizeable investments back to the state for years to come."

ELECTRIC AIRCRAFTS

Joby, a leader in the electric aircraft field, will be making over \$40 million of capital investments and creating nearly 700 new jobs as part of its expansion efforts in Santa Cruz and Marina.

AIBOT received a \$15 million grant to further its manufacturing and R&D capabilities in Long Beach and Mojave as it continues developing artificial intelligence software and building autonomous electric aircrafts. In exchange, they will create almost 700 new jobs and invest nearly \$500 million across the two locations.

SEMICONDUCTORS & MICROCHIPS

Two California businesses will be expanding their efforts to increase domestic production of the next generation of semiconductors and microchips in the hopes of attracting additional federal investments through the CHIPS Act.

Tynergy received a \$15 million grant to relocate its headquarters from Wyoming to Fresno, where they will manufacture semiconductors and energy storage systems. In the process, they will create at least 500 new, full-time jobs and make nearly \$21 million of capital investments in the region.

Infinera, a semiconductor chip developer and manufacturer, received a \$14 million grant to expand its operations in San Jose and Sunnyvale. Between the two locations, they will make over \$180 million of capital investments and create nearly 250 new jobs.

NEXT-GENERATION EV BATTERIES

Sparkz, a lithium iron phosphate battery manufacturer, received an \$11.2 million grant to create 500 new, full-time jobs and make over \$83 million in capital investments in Rancho Cordova.

AUGMENTED REALITY, ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, AND MORE

Snapchat, who is expanding their operations in Palo Alto, San Francisco and Santa Monica, will use their award to advance their manufacturing capabilities for their augmented reality devices.

Helm.ai and Humane, both of whom will use their award to further develop artificial intelligence software, will be expanding their respective operations in San Francisco and the broader Bay Area.

The California Competes Tax Credit was created in 2013 to help businesses grow and stay in California. GO-Biz evaluates the most competitive applications based on the factors required by statute, including total jobs created, total investment, wages and benefits paid to employees, economic impact, strategic importance and more. In 2022, the program was extended for an additional five years with at least \$180 million in tax credits available for allocation to businesses each year through 2028.

The California Competes Grant Program was created in 2021 and extended each of the following two years, with a total of \$120 million allocated for the 2023-24 fiscal year. A significant priority for this grant program is to make resources available to businesses who cannot take advantage of a non-refundable tax credit and is one of the state's main incentive programs to leverage tens of billions of federal funds available under the Creating Helpful Incentives to Produce Semiconductors (CHIPS) Act, and to encourage growth and expansion of semiconductor manufacturing and research and development in California.

In total, CalCompetes has awarded grants and tax credits to more than 1,200 businesses, creating nearly 165,000 jobs.

Sherwin-Williams' HQ2: how big?

Height may depend on parking deck perimeter uses

A COMMENTARY

Just as NEOtrans was publishing breaking news Nov. 10 that Sherwin-Williams in 2024 would advance planning for the second phase of its headquarters, a trusted source responded with some remarkable data. That source provided employment data for Sherwin-Williams' various office locations in Greater Cleveland and in Minneapolis which shows the company is dramatically expanding with new jobs that, if continued, shows the urgency in the company's consideration of a second headquarters structure in downtown Cleveland, hereinafter referred to as HQ2. And based on that employment information and other insights, it is likely to be a significant structure or structures.

The new 616-foot-tall headquarters that's near to topping out west of downtown's Public Square is expected to accommodate upwards of 3,100 employees. Some estimates put the

total as high as 3,500. HQ1 is scheduled to welcome those employees one year from now. But that 1.1-million-square-foot complex which includes a two-story pavilion fronting Public Square and a 920-space parking deck just north of the tower on West 3rd Street are already proving to be insufficient to accommodate Sherwin-Williams' growth. That is why the company will reportedly spend the next year considering design options for HQ2.

Sherwin has the resources to move forward on HQ2. It sold a 90-percent stake in HQ1 to Florida-based Benderson Realty Development Co. for \$210 million. If planning advances throughout 2024 to where it becomes public a year from now, as sources say it will, that positions financing and construction to move forward on HQ2 in 2025. That's when interest rates are expected to come down below 6 percent and make big projects more affordable again. Sherwin-Williams' staff has not responded to NEOtrans' inquiries about the prospects for HQ2.
