

Building Insights: Construction cost increases accompanied by tariff anxiety

Construction costs continue to increase each month along with increased anxiety and even fear about trade disputes and additional tariffs on steel, aluminum and lumber. The Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that the cost of all goods for construction increased 8.8 percent from May 2017 to May 2018. Some of the largest increases during that period were in diesel fuel, aluminum mill shapes and lumber and plywood.

Construction prices have risen for 19 consecutive months, and industry observers do not expect any reduction in costs in the near future. Construction industry groups have placed a majority of the blame for rising costs on trade disputes and the threat of serious trade wars. They also believe that more disruption and increases are on their way.

The cost of goods used in construction jumped in April at the fastest year-over-year rate since 2011. These ongoing increases for a wide range of building materials, including many that are subject to proposed tariffs, could drive prices still higher and cause scarcities, according to an analysis of Labor Department data by the Associated General Contractors of America.

Association officials said that the new data indicate many firms already are being impacted by higher materials prices that they are unable to pass along to their customers.

“Contractors have started to boost the prices they charge, but they are falling further behind on the cost of materials they buy,” said the association’s chief economist, Ken Simonson. “This imbalance poses two risks: Either contractors will suffer decreased profit margins, or project owners with fixed budgets will cut back on the projects they undertake.”

Commercial contractors are going to have to be very strategic and creative in dealing with the rising cost of materials and the overall cost of new construction projects. One result is that the new tariffs have initiated a surge in construction material orders. The demand for construction materials at this accelerated rate also is causing concern and challenges for construction material manufacturers and suppliers because they may not be able to produce the products quickly enough to meet the demand.

The disruption caused by not being able to meet the demand for products on time will lead to other consequences, such as construction project delays and budget overruns. And even more seriously, it possibly could lead developers to halt or postpone starts of future construction projects.

The anxiety and even fear about the impact of tariffs on materials prices and demand means that prices are likely to increase further as the new trade restrictions come into effect. This then will force contractors to pay more for materials and wait longer to receive them, make construction projects more expensive and increase the time to complete the projects.

Associated Builders and Contractors provided this list of materials commonly used in construction and how much their costs rose in May:

- Aluminum mill shapes, 17.3 percent.
- Lumber and plywood, 13.9 percent.
- Copper and brass, 13.8 percent.
- Steel mill products, 10.5 percent.
- Diesel fuel, 44.5 percent.
- Asphalt felts and coatings, 8.9 percent.
- Ready-mixed concrete, 6.5 percent.

• Paving mixtures and blocks, 5.2 percent.

Rising subcontractor costs are caused by a limited supply in many cases. Labor costs are rising, and companies are facing a real struggle to retain good workers. Labor shortages will continue to be a challenge for the construction industry due to a lack of skilled labor, stricter government policies and an inability to recruit millennials.

One real concern for commercial contractors is that the new tariffs will bring increased cost pressures as they struggle to deal with rising materials costs, meaning less capital available to invest in personnel and new technology that can make them more efficient.
