PREQUALIFICATION OF PROSPECTIVE DESIGN BIDDERS:

The University's primary objective in utilizing the design build approach is to bring the best available integrated design and construction experience to this project. The University has determined that proposers who submit proposals on this project must be prequalified. Prequalified proposers will be required to have the following California contractor's licenses:

B - GENERAL BUILDING AND

C20 - WARM-AIR HEATING, VENTILATING AND AIR-CONDITIONING (HVAC)

The Design Build contract will require the successful Design Builder, hereinafter referred also as "Bidder", to provide both engineering design and construction services in an occupied research laboratory. The Design Build Team must consist of the following: General Contractor (Bidder) who holds both General Contractor's Class B and C20 license and State of California licensed Mechanical Engineer of Record who is an employee of the Bidder. Furthermore the team must have control system design and integration capabilities, laboratory equipment installation, electrical and architectural capabilities and Testing and Air Balancing capabilities. The team proposed must have worked on similar projects together. The bidder must have the capability of modeling existing building conditions as well as new construction in BIM. In addition, the firm must comply with the laws of the State of California applicable to such firms. All information required herein shall be submitted within the following parameters: (1) the Proposer shall hold all required licenses; and (2) the Bidder shall be the financially responsible entity for bonding and insurance.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

The project is to modify the chemical fume hood system from constant air volume to variable air volume. The project is located on the UCSF Mission Bay Campus, Genentech Hall north side of the 5th floor in the following spaces: Wet Chemistry Laboratory Room numbers N514, N516, N574, and N576 and the associated ancillary lab support rooms that adjoin the main labs. The total project area is 14,200 GSF and houses 72 constant volume chemical fume hoods.

The project site is occupied and fully operational.

The scope of work includes but is not limited to the modification and/or addition of exhaust air valves and controls, supply air valves and controls and integration with existing air handling supply and exhaust fans and the existing building management system. The Work

includes new ductwork to be added and existing ductwork will be rerouted and modified as appropriate while limiting disruption to existing architectural and structural elements. The electrical scope of work is to provide power and infrastructure as needed for the new control systems. The electrical scope may also include light fixture relocations. The project modifies the existing 8' chemical fume hoods with horizontal/vertical sash combinations from constant volume operations to variable volume operation, adds zone presence sensors to fume hoods to reduce face velocity when hoods are unoccupied. The Work includes air balancing to rebalance the laboratories, support spaces and all other spaces and systems affected by the work and confirm operations at each chemical fume hood (max and min) and labs (max and min).

The building's automation system is propriety using the Invensys Building Systems (IBS) a Schneider Electric company. The Work includes control's configuration that requires system integration.

Bidding documents prepared by UCSF to illustrate the University's program and performance goals for the project will be provided with the proposal documents.

Design Build example projects for this prequalification will be considered to meet 'similar scope and values' if the projects include design and construction of a VAV fume hood project and associated controls involving the retrofit or installation of at least 20 fume hoods. Each example project should have a total construction cost of \$500,000 or greater at time of completion.

The estimated construction cost is approximately \$1,000,000. The maximum acceptance cost will be established when the Request for Proposal (RFP) is issued. The tentative start dates for the design and construction are as follows:

Design – start May 2013

Construction – start June 2013; 3 months duration

The start dates, durations and maximum acceptance cost will be further clarified in the RFP.

UCSF PROJECT GOALS:

UCSF is utilizing the design build approach to bring the optimal available integrated design and construction experience to this project. UCSF have identified the following goals on which this project will be deemed successful.

1. Deliver an energy efficient project with safe laboratory operation.
2. Ensure there is minimum disruption to existing laboratories during design and construction phases and maintain a functioning HVAC system with required controls during the construction phase.
3. Provide seamless air balance and commissioning phase with minimum disruption to laboratory occupants ensuring project area is properly balanced maintaining required pressurization between spaces and does not change or effect overall building pressurization.

PREQUALIFICATION PROCESS

The prequalification process will result in the selection of finalists who will be prequalified and will be issued Request for Proposal (RFP) documents for this Project.

The prequalified proposers will submit price and technical proposals. The technical proposals will be scored according to an established scoring system. The price will be divided by the score to determine a price per technical point. The prequalified proposer submitting the lowest price per technical point will be the apparent low proposer for the Project.
