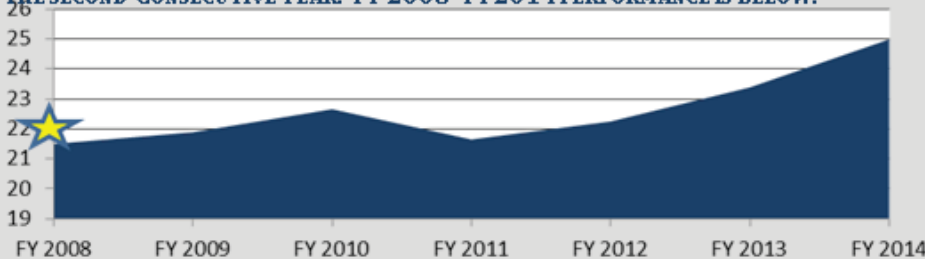


Federal Government Achieves 2014 Small Business Procurement Contracting Goal for Second Consecutive Year

Small Business Contracting and the Federal Government

Each year, the United States government spends nearly half a trillion dollars on goods and services. By statute, it must ensure that 23 percent of that amount is spent with American small businesses – thereby resulting in real jobs for everyday Americans. Since taking office, SBA Administrator Maria Contreras-Sweet has worked tirelessly to ensure that President Obama's commitment to small businesses to get the tools and resources to succeed is realized. In fiscal year 2014, 24.99 percent or \$91.7 billion were awarded to small business contractors, resulting in the support of approximately 550,000 total jobs.

How Government Contracting Can Have a Direct Impact on the Economy of a Local Community

In small towns throughout the country, many residents may be employed by the local factory or manufacturing facility in their communities. And quite often, these businesses are federal government contractors.

Contracting can be a win-win for businesses and the government. Small businesses get the revenue they need to grow and create jobs, and the

government benefits from working with some of the most innovative and responsive businesses in the world.

The Federal Government's Fiscal Year 2014 Small Business Procurement Scorecard

The SBA is the government agency responsible for ensuring that the Administration meets the statutorily defined goals for small business procurement. Each year, SBA negotiates with agencies to establish individual agency goals that, in the aggregate, constitute the government-wide goals.

During President Obama's first six years in office, the federal government awarded \$550.7 billion in federal contracting dollars to small businesses. This represents an \$88 billion increase over the preceding six years, even as we have reduced contracting spending overall – a direct result of this Administration's government-wide focus on increasing small business contracting opportunities.

SBA's annual "Small Business Procurement Scorecard" is an assessment tool which measures federal agency and government-wide achievement of the small business and socio-economic prime contracting and subcontracting goals. This fiscal year marks the second consecutive year that the federal government has met and exceeded its Congressionally-mandated goal.
