# What You Need To Know About Training and Apprenticeship Programs



The right hire makes all the difference on construction and infrastructure projects. Nobody wants errors that cost time and money, or worse, injuries on the job site. That's why a hiring a prepared workforce is one of the most important decisions a contractor can make.

Today's skilled workers have received a combination of classroom learning and hands-on experience to make certain they have what's needed to succeed. Workers who have experience with a range of topics from construction fundamentals to blue print reading to concrete techniques to green construction to landscaping are an invaluable asset for contractors.

"We work closely with our signatory contractors to develop our curriculum and to respond to their changing needs," said Scott Gordon, Executive Director of The Laborers Training School & Apprenticeship Program in Southern California. "We recently worked with our signatory contractors to incorporate tilt-up work processes into our curriculum because in Southern California tilt up construction is booming due to increased online commerce and the need for online retailers to meet their distribution and warehousing needs."

Becoming a construction trade journeyperson is not easy. For example, it requires 4,000 training hours in order to become a LiUNA journeyperson. That means that journeymen and women are highly trained professionals who have invested extensive time and energy in their career and carry the experience necessary to get the job done right. However, the rewards of joining an apprenticeship program are great. Students are able to "earn-while-they-learn," and they get state-of-
