Greetings!

"Project Labor Agreements don't cost more! They even save money!"

That's what union lobbyists and their political friends say all the time. It doesn't make sense.

Either these politicians are fools, or they know the truth but don't care. They want their union friends to enjoy a monopoly on their contracts.

At local government meetings, the Coalition for Fair Employment has to explain how burdensome regulations such as Project Labor Agreements cut bid competition and increase costs.

Here's the latest evidence that Project Labor Agreements cut competition and increase costs at the expense of the taxpayers:

# 1. Hacienda La Puente Unified School District

This school district, located east of Los Angeles, required contractors to sign Project Labor Agreements for two contracts that it had bid unsuccessfully earlier in the year. On October 10, the school board will AGAIN reject all bids for these two projects.

For the Cedarlane Entry Canopy project, the two low bidders did not sign the "Letter of Assent" that binds them to the Project Labor Agreement.

Both bids were deemed as non-responsive. The third lowest bidder, at \$374,123, was 40% higher than the low bid of \$260,000.

For the La Puente High School Dressing Room, Pool, and Kitchen, the three lowest bidders did not sign the "Letter of Assent" that binds them to the Project Labor Agreement. Another bidder made a mistake, leaving only one out of the five bidders as responsive. The \$7 million bid of this contractor was 27% higher than the low bid of \$5.5 million that was disqualified because of refusal to sign the Project Labor Agreement.

# 2. City of Berkeley

On October 15, the Berkeley City Council will vote to reject the low bid of \$983,000 for the James Kenney Park, Picnic, and Play Area Renovation Project. This contract includes renovation of the picnic and playground area, replacement of the play equipment, and improvements to other site amenities in conformance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Yes, the City of Berkeley wants to preserve labor peace on this playground renovation project with a Project Labor Agreement. But the low bidder listed a subcontractor that stated it "cannot agree" to the city's Project Labor Agreement (described in Berkeley as a "Community Workforce Agreement, or CWA) and stated it would request an exemption from the Project Labor Agreement.

The other bidder submitted a bid protest about this, and the City of Berkeley deemed the low bidder to be non-responsive. The second lowest bid was \$992,785 - only one percent higher, but indeed higher. See the agenda item here:

Three clear cases in which a Project Labor Agreement cut bid competition and increased costs for taxpayers.

These happen on a daily basis and CFEC is there to highlight PLA corruption and thier inevitable failures so that other, more responsible entities, can avoid the same mistakes as they who actually agree to PLAs.
