How Payday Loans Work for People With Bad Credit

If you have bad credit, you know firsthand just how tough it is to get a loan. This might not affect your everyday life, but sometimes life takes unexpected turns and you'll be faced with a situation where you need cash now. Maybe your car broke down and you need it to get to work. Or your child broke his foot and needed medical care. Now, you're stuck trying to make the rent. Whatever the reasons are, the bottom line is you need cash and you can't let your bad credit get in the way.

Fortunately, there's still an option open to you: A payday loan. Even with bad credit, you can get a payday loan. Here's how it works.

The Only Real Requirement for Payday Loans

Many payday loans today not only don't require high credit, but won't even check your credit rating at all.

Instead, what they're looking at is your employment stability, history and pay. They want to know that you have the capability to repay. A credit history shows your tendency to repay in the past, but your current employment demonstrates whether you have the money necessary coming in to repay the loan.

With a payday loan, that's all the lender cares about. So even with poor credit, you can still get the money you need.

What the Process Looks Like

There are many different ways to get a payday loan. You can walk into a physical dealer in your neighborhood. You can do an application by phone or by fax. Or you can handle the whole thing over the internet.

Generally speaking, the amount you'll be able to take out depends entirely upon your income. If you're asking for a \$1,500 payday loan but your monthly income is \$800, chances are they won't give you the full amount. On the other hand, if your monthly income is \$2,000 and you're only asking for \$700, there's a very good chance you'll get all you asked for.

What Kind of Documentation Do You Need?

It depends entirely on the lender. Some lenders will require you to fax in your pay stubs, proof of employment and other such documentation. Other lenders won't require any documentation at all. Some lenders will want to call you and talk to you on the phone to confirm the facts, while others won't do this either.

The whole process from beginning your loan application to receiving your money can happen in as little as 24 hours. Lenders understand that most people who're using payday loans need to get access to money quickly, so they've created their systems around maximizing their speed.

Receiving and Paving the Money

Receiving your money is very simple. To expedite the process, most lenders today do wire transfers. That means instead of having to wait for a check to arrive in the mail and for the check to clear, you'll have the money show up directly in your bank account. Again, the money can literally be in your bank account within 24 hours of you beginning your application process.

How you pay back the lender depends on the lender. Some lenders prefer a physical check payment, while others prefer having the money wired back. Make sure you understand the repayment terms and methods before getting your loan.

How Does it Affect Your Credit?

By and large, getting a payday loan doesn't affect your credit. Most payday lenders don't report to the credit bureaus. That means nobody will ever know you took out a payday loan. It won't improve your credit and it won't damage your credit either.

On the other hand, if you don't repay the loan, it will damage your credit. If you don't repay the loan, the payday lender will report the loan to at least one credit agency. If you want to improve your credit, you definitely want to make sure you repay your loan on time.

Getting a payday loan with bad credit isn't difficult. All you really need is a steady job. Payday lenders understand that often time's people won't have the credit to get traditional loans. That's why payday loans are the perfect solution for cash crunches, especially if you can't get money through more traditional means. Getting money through payday loans is fast, easy and painless.
