The SBDC program is one of our nation's largest small business assistance programs within the federal government, made up of a unique mix of SBA federal funds, state and SBDCs are often hosted by leading universities and state economic development agencies, and are funded in part through a partnership with the Small Business Administration. SBDCs serve all populations and many types of business owners, including women, minorities,

and veterans-including reservists, active duty, disabled personnel, and those returning from deployment. They also assist personnel with disabilities, youth and encore entrepreneurs, and individuals in low- and moderate-income urban and rural areas. 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
